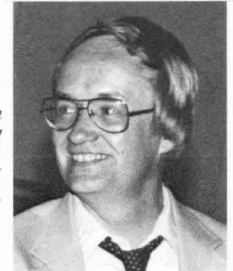

The above officers compose the AFA Executive Board and will expedite the affairs of the AFA with wisdom and dispatch.

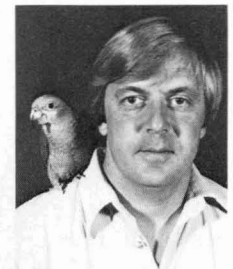
