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FRONT COVER

Cassowaries are downy and delightful in their juvenile plumage but they grow into large, heavy birds five feet tall. They are naturally shy birds but can become extremely aggressive and dangerous. Mickey Ollson's Cassowary attacked a worker riding a tractor-type mower. When the man escaped, the bird rendered great damage to the machine.
